Urologists are more and more involved in pudendal somatosensory evoked potentials and in the intensive care unit evoked potentials are used in order to monitor the functional state of the central nervous system of the patient. This overwhelming number of examinations and examinations clearly demonstrates the need for guidelines and standardization of the methods used. The evoked potential methodology is restricted by the relative poor signal to noise ratio. In many diseases this signal to noise ratio decreases rapidly during the progression of the illness. Optimal technical equipment and methodology are therefore essential.
